BREAKOUT SESSIONS

Central Data Exchange (CDX) Registration: This session will guide participants through the process of creating or updating an account with EPA's Central Data Exchange system. Jordan Thaeler of the National Biodiesel Board will give a step-by-step demonstration of how renewable fuels producers can complete this initial step for RFS-2 registration.

Third Party Engineering Review: Since the publishing of the Final RFS-2 Rule, perhaps no topic has created more confusion and concern than the requirement for all renewable fuels producers to complete a third party engineering review for RFS-2 registration. In this breakout, Karl Simon from EPA will clarify the requirements for third party engineering reviews, and representatives from the engineering field will describe the services offered by their companies to assist producers in meeting these new requirements.

Introduction to EMTS/RINs: EPA's Moderated Transaction System (EMTS) is a brand new, web-based system for screening, trading and tracking all RINs generated under RFS-2. This session, moderated by Tony Miller of EPA and representatives of the Renewable Fuels Association and the National Biodiesel Board, will detail the process of properly registering for and using EMTS so that participants will be RIN-ready on July 1, 2010.

Pathway for Fuel Pathways: The new RFS-2 rules will allow EPA, in conjunction with renewable fuels producers, to create and approve new “fuel pathways” for plant expansions, process/technology innovations and feedstock advancements. Larry Schafer of the National Biodiesel Board will guide participants through the procedures outlined in the RFS-2 rules for opening new “fuel pathways” at renewable fuels facilities in the future.
